
















## Thirty Second Guide to iMovie HD

If you want to:	Do this:
Import Pictures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drag the image into the Clips Pane </li> <li>OR</li> <li>• Go to File / Import (Note: See <i>Use The Ken Burns Effect</i> below.)</li> </ul>
Add images to the movie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drag the image from the Clips window to the Time Line.</li> <li>• To change the duration, Double click on the image or change the Ken Burns Effect ( See next item).</li> </ul> 
Use (or turn off) The Ken Burns Effect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highlight the picture</li> <li>• Click <i>Media / Photos</i> buttons</li> <li>• Click <i>Show Photo Settings</i></li> <li>• Check the box beside Ken Burns Effect (uncheck for off)</li> <li>• Click <i>Start</i> –</li> <li>• Drag the size and speed slider</li> <li>• Click <i>End</i> –</li> <li>• Drag the size and speed slider</li> <li>• Click Update</li> </ul> 
Add a transition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the <i>Editing</i> Button. </li> <li>• Click the <i>Transitions</i> Button.</li> <li>• Choose a transition and adjust the speed by sliding the speed slider.</li> <li>• Drag the desired transition between two images.</li> <li>• Wait for the transition to render (red line).</li> </ul>
Add photos from iPhoto	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the <i>Media</i> Button </li> <li>• Click the <i>Photos</i> button.</li> <li>• Decided if you want Ken Burns and click the Show Photo Settings Button.</li> <li>• Drag the desired photo to the Time Line.</li> </ul>
Add Music from iTunes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the <i>Media</i> Button </li> <li>• Click the <i>Audio</i> Button</li> <li>• Choose music from iTunes or Garageband and preview music by clicking on the Preview button </li> <li>• Click on the Time line Viewer icon </li> <li>• Place the Playhead where you want the music to start </li> <li>• Click the Place at Playhead button.</li> </ul>
Record Voice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the <i>Media</i> Button </li> <li>• Click the <i>Audio</i> Button</li> <li>• Click on the Time line Viewer icon </li> <li>• Click the Record Icon and speak into the microphone</li> </ul>
Split an Audio / Video Track	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click on the Time line Viewer icon </li> <li>• Place the Playhead on the part of the  audio or video track where you would like to split.</li> <li>• Under Edit, find SPLIT AUDIO (VIDEO) CLIP AT PLAYHEAD.</li> </ul>

Adjust music volume	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highlight the audio track in the time line viewer.</li> <li>• Under VIEW drag to <i>Show Clip Volume Levels</i></li> <li>• Drag the level line up or down with the CLIP icon.</li> <li>• To adjust the volume on part of a track click on the volume line and drag the small button.</li> </ul>  
Add titles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click on the <i>Editing</i> Button.</li> <li>• Click on the <i>Titles</i> Button</li> <li>• Choose the type of title.</li> <li>• Type desired text in title window</li> <li>• Click Over Black to see title on black screen</li> <li>• Drag title in front of clip on Clip Viewer</li> </ul>
