













30 Second Guide to Making Animation With Keynote

If You Want to:	Do This:
Start Keynote	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find Keynote in the iWork '08 folder in the applications folder. 
Create Set Up Slides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> From the menu bar click INSERT / CHOOSE . Insert each image onto a separate slide.
Resize and Rotate Images	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To resize images, highlight the image and drag any white box on the image outline. To rotate images, highlight the image, hold the APPLE KEY, and drag a corner white box. (You will see a curved arrow.) 
Remove the Background Color From the Animation Figures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the image. Click on the ALPHA button on the Menu. Drag the cursor over the colors that you wish to remove (make invisible). Hit return.  <p>Before ->  After -> </p>
Make the Animation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place the background image onto the first slide. Copy / Paste the animation characters onto the background slide. (Resize if necessary) Single Click on this slide in the Slides bar on the left. Make a copy of this first slide and paste it as slide 2. Click on slide 2 and drag the animation figure(s) as short distance.    <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Copy /Paste slide 2 and continue moving the figure(s). Repeat these steps.

<p>Add Narration to a Whole Slide Show</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start on the first slide. • Open the INSPECTOR MENU • Click the DOCUMENT INSPECTOR icon.  • Choose AUDIO and click RECORD under SLIDESHOW RECORDING. (You will see a red dot in the top left corner of the screen). • Speak into the build-in microphone. • Click the mouse or use the right arrow key to advance to the next slide. • The slideshow will end at the end of the recording. • When you PLAY the slideshow, it will advance automatically using the same timings used in the narration.
<p>Play Audio As Background as Slide Show Plays</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open the INSPECTOR MENU • Click the DOCUMENT INSPECTOR icon.  • Choose AUDIO and click ITUNES LIBRARY. • Drag the music file into the SOUNDTRACK window and choose how often you want it to play. 
<p>Save Keynote as In Other Formats</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under FILE, drag to Export. Choose the desired format.  • For Quicktime, make sure the settings are these:
