









Thirty Second Guide to Dreamweaver

Before creating pages, create a new folder called *webproject* in your Sites folder. Save all pages and pictures to this folder.

In order to:	Do this:
Start an new page	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Choose <i>HTML</i> under <i>Create New</i> on the DreamWeaver window. 
Format Text	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlight the text Look for the desired format in the Text Properties window. 
Create a Link	Type the URL or name of page in the <i>Link</i> section of the <i>Text Properties</i> page.
Insert an image	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the <i>Image</i> Icon on the menu bar. Choose the type of image. Hint: Be sure all images are saved as .jpg or .gif in your <i>Sites</i> folder. 
Add a Table	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the <i>Table</i> icon. Choose table options in the Table window. 
Format a Table	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Highlight the table, choose options from the Table Properties Window. Hint: Use tables to align pictures and text. 
Preview the page	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the Preview in Browser icon. You may have to tell Dreamweaver which browser to use. (Safari or Internet Explorer) 
Add a Flash Button	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Under INSERT choose MEDIA then FLASH BUTTON. Choose the type of button you want. Enter the Button Text Enter the link address in the LINK box. Click OK

<p>How to import music from a CD without using iTunes:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Double click on the CD icon. • Open iMovie. • Under FILE, drag to IMPORT and choose the desired track from CD. • After the track has been imported into iMovie, go to FILE and drag to SHARE. • Choose QUICKTIME • Choose COMPRESS MOVIE FOR: → <i>email</i>. • Click SHARE and share the track to your sites folder.
<p>How to insert music or a Movie</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under INSERT, drag to MEDIA. • Choose PLUGIN. • Select the desired media from the sits folder.
<p>Radio Buttons</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose FORMS on the Insert Bar  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on the RADIO GROUP button • In the Radio Group box, Type a Name in the descriptive NAME section. • Click the word “Radio” under the Label column. Change it to your first category name. • Click on the word “radio” under the Value column. Change it to your first what you want to recorded. • If there are more than two categories, click the + sign to add more. • Click OK. 
<p>Submit/Reset Button</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Button button on the Insert Bar. (<i>If you asked to “ Add Form Tag” say yes</i>) • Click on the SUBMIT button. In the Property Inspector make sure action is set to <i>submit</i> or Reset
